

Explore the historic city and admire the castle as you wander through the bustling centre with its many shops, cafés and galleries. The rest of the day can be spent in beautiful Beauly. Discover its array of traditional pubs and restaurants or take a leisurely riverside walk.

Day Three: The highlight for most will be today's journey on one of the world's finest coast-to-coast railways to the Kyle of Lochalsh, overlooking the Isle of Skye. This spectacular train ride is undoubtedly one of the most scenic rail journeys in the United Kingdom. Rejoin the coach for an equally interesting return via Loch Ness.

Day Four: Venture north along the east coast to Golspie and a visit to fairytale Dunrobin Castle. Enjoy the magnificent gardens and views across the sea before heading to the lovely historic town of Dornoch, with its independent shops and cafés.
