**Day One:** Depart from your selected joining point and travel to Aberfoyle for your four nights stay at the Rob Roy Hotel. Comfort stops will be made en-route.

**Day Two:** Journey through the glorious Loch Lomond and The Trossachs National Park to see the stunning Falls of Dochart at Loch Tay. Spend time in the attractive town of Crieff, which has a reputation for fine food and a great choice of cafés and coffee shops. Then join a cruise on the beautiful Loch Katrine, popular since Sir Walter Scott's vivid descriptions inspired tourists to see the landscape for themselves.

**Day Three:** Visit The Kelpies, the largest equine sculptures in the world and the nearby Falkirk Wheel, where you board a boat to be hoisted 35 metres on the world's only rotating boat lift. Then to the historic city of Stirling, known as the 'wee city with a big history'. It is dominated by the castle, which offers panoramic views of the mountains and the Wallace Monument.

**Day Four:** Take a cruise on the mesmerising Loch Lomond and enjoy the views of Ben Lomond, stately homes and castles along the shoreline. There will be some free time in the village of Balloch and the graceful, Victorian town of Helensburgh.

**Day Five:** After breakfast you leave Aberfoyle and travel home. Comfort stops will be made en-route.
