Its picturesque setting along the River Wear and its well-preserved architecture, make it a charming and historic city in the UK. The Market Place is a central hub and features a range of shops.

Day Three: Relax on a scenic journey through the Durham Dales, an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, to the market town of Barnard Castle with its popular Wednesday Market. On to Bowes Museum, a spectacular French-style château with ornate gardens, which is home to the exquisite Silver Swan.
