

Easter in Fort William

5-day holiday near Fort William with excursion(s) in the Scottish Highlands area. The cost of the holiday and any additional charges will be stated on your confirmation invoice. All sums include taxes where applicable.

Day One: Depart from your selected joining point and travel via Callander to the stunning Falls of Dochart, where a short break will be made for photographs. Travel on to Fort William for your four nights stay at the Ben Nevis Hotel and Leisure Club. Comfort stops will be made en-route.

Day Two: Oban is the capital of North Argyll and is full of things to see and do. You may like to visit McCaig's Tower, the replica of the Colosseum that is such a distinctive feature on the Oban skyline. The view across Oban Bay to Kerrera and Mull is unparalleled.

Day Three: Admire the beautiful scenery as you travel through Fort Augustus and along the shores of the mystical Loch Ness to the floral city of Inverness 'Capital of the Highlands'. Perhaps enjoy a stroll along the river and the streets to discover the museums, galleries, castle and shops.

Day Four: A half day excursion along the famous 'Road to the Isles', seeing the Glenfinnan Viaduct, to the thriving port of Mallaig, followed by a light lunch at the Ben Nevis Hotel. Our coach will then take you into Fort William.

Day Five: After breakfast you leave Fort William and travel home via the 'Bonnie Banks of Loch Lomond'. Comfort stops will be made en-route.
